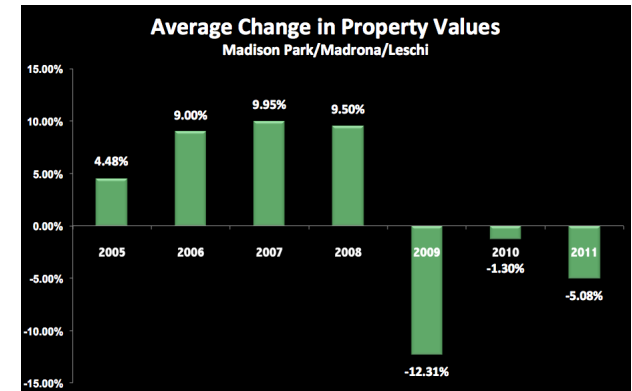

Trending values is the recognition that things change. The principle of change holds that change is inevitable and results from cause and effect relationships.

We are going to look at some of those cause and effect relationships as well as how to measure the changes. Sales ratios will be one of the main measures looked at and how we can use the ratios to help determine where trending should take place. We will see how sales ratios can be used for the entire municipality, certain neighborhoods and even specific building styles to guide us to the correct assessment adjustments.

How can we use RPSV4 to assist us in choosing the correct trending factor will be discussed and the use of Excel to defend our choices will be explained.

The use of the three measures of central tendency will be reviewed and the use of COD's to measure the uniformity between market segments will be explained.
